GRADUATE ATTRIBUTES

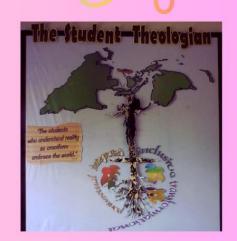
Upon graduation at IFRS, students must be able to embody the following qualities:

 - Pay fees in person.

For On-site application Please follow the procedure below:

1st step: Submission of Requirements

- a. Go to the Registrar's office and submit all the original copies of the requirements
- b. Fill out the Personal Data Sheet and submit the completed form to the Registrar

2nd Step: Payment for English Assessment Test (EAT) Fee

 a. Go to the Business office and Pay the English Assessment Test Fee
 b. Go back to the Registrar's office to get the Schedule for English Assessment Test and the Interview Schedule with the Dean

3rd Step: Placement Examination: English Assessment Test (EAT)

- a. Go to the Dean's office to get the English Assessment Test paper and proceed to the library to take the examination for 3 Hours
- b. When done, submit the English Assessment Test Paper to the Dean and come back for the scheduled interview $\,$

4th step: Interview with the Dean

a. Go to the Dean's office for the result of the English Assessment Test b. The Dean will give an endorsement to the registrar on whether to enroll in an English Enhancement Program or not

5th Step: Program Evaluation and Advising

- a. The registrar will evaluate further the submitted requirements
- b. A hard copy of the Course Curriculum guide based on the chosen program will be given upon the approval of the Dean
- c. Fill out the Application for Admission Form (Form A-001) and submit the completed form to the registrar's office for final checking and signature

6th Step: Final Enlistment

- a. Fill out the Pre-registration form (Form A-008) following the Course Curriculum Guide given by the Registrar
- b. Go to the Dean's office for final program advising and signing of the form A- 008 (Pre-registration form)

7th Step: Assessment and Payment of Tuition & Other Fees

- a. Go to the Business office for Tuition Fee assessment and payment. Bring the Pre-registration form (Form A-008) for the cashier's signature and stamped (paid/partially paid)
- b. Get the Official Receipt of payment at the Business office
